To : All Sri Lankans living in Israel,

Limitation of Consular Services

Further to the previous Notices issued by the Embassy of Sri Lanka regarding the spread of Corona virus pandemic in Israel.

Taking into consideration of the high risk associated with the spread of the COVID – 19, the Embassy of Sri Lanka limits the consular services until further notice, in order to minimize the exposure / spread of the virus amongst the Sri Lankans those who will be visiting the Embassy to obtain consular services.

However, the Embassy will provide the following urgent consular services and to obtain such services Sri Lankans are requested to make early appointments prior to visit the Embassy.

- 1). Issuance of Emergency Travel Documents for Sri Lanka Citizens (NMRP)
- 2). Issuance of Certifications relating to death of Sri Lankan National
- 3). Urgent inquiries regarding COVID – 19 pandemic
- 4). Any other emergency services
