



Important Notice

To: All Sri Lankan Caregivers on vacation in Sri Lanka,

This is further to the previous Notices issued by the Embassy of Sri Lanka regarding the spread of Corona Virus pandemic in Israel.

The Ministry of Interior of Israel has issued the following guidelines on return to Israel by the caregivers who have left Israel prior to 18.03.2020 with Re-entry Visas.

Accordingly, you are kindly requested to draw your attention to the below mentioned guidelines;

1. The caregiver must stay in quarantine for 14 days at the same place during the entire duration (NOT in the employer's home) from the time of re-entry into Israel.
2. The employer is responsible for the caregiver's quarantine, including the caregiver's basic needs including food and medical insurance.
3. The employer must make sure that the caregiver arrives directly to the place of quarantine from the airport.
4. The caregiver will have to sign a declaration BEFORE ARRIVING IN ISRAEL, that he/she is willing to stay 14 days in quarantine (without the salary).
5. When the caregiver enters into Israel, the employer must report immediately to the Ministry of Health regarding his/her arrival at the place of quarantine.
6. If the caregiver develops symptoms or gets sick during the quarantine, the Ministry of Health will act according to the case. There is a chance that the caregiver will have to stay in quarantine more than 14 days, if they develop symptoms.
7. THE PLACEMENT AGENCY (Foreign Employment Agency) in Israel is responsible for applying for the Re-entry Visa, after all the requirements are met.
8. After the application is approved, the caregiver will get the Re-entry Visa from the nearest Israeli Consulate/Embassy.
