



Important Notice

To: All prospective Passengers/Travelers to Sri Lanka,

Temporary Ban on Passengers

Please note that in order to prevent the spread of Corona Virus pandemic in Sri Lanka, the Civil Aviation Authority of Sri Lanka has imposed a **temporary ban on all travel beginning from Italy, South Korea and Iran** with effect from **14th March 2020** for two weeks.

The Civil Aviation Authority has also informed that all travel beginning from **France, Spain, Germany, Switzerland, Denmark, The Netherlands, Sweden, Austria** to Sri Lanka will be banned from **15th March 2020 for two weeks**. The travel ban will commence on all flights arriving after **23.59 hrs. (local time in Sri Lanka) on 15th March 2020 and end at 24.00 hrs. (local time in Sri Lanka) on 29th March 2020**.

In addition to that the Civil Aviation Authority has informed that all travel beginning from **United Kingdom, Belgium and Norway** to Sri Lanka will be banned from **16th March 2020 for two weeks**. The travel ban will commence on all flights arriving after **23.59 hrs. (local time in Sri Lanka) on 16th March 2020 and end at 24.00 hrs. (local time in Sri Lanka) on 30th March 2020**.

Furthermore, Civil Aviation Authority of Sri Lanka has strongly instructed to all airlines not to board any passenger who is either originating from the aforementioned countries or who has been to any of those countries within the last 14 days, in any of their flights destined to Sri Lanka during the aforementioned period.
